### GALESBURG HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS

1. The Allric Anderson Memorial Award is awarded to a GHS senior with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 to 2.5 from their junior year. Criteria include perseverance, dependability, majoring in education with a career goal of becoming a school counselor. **Deadline: April 1, 2011.**
2. American Legion Ralph Noble Unit #285 Scholarship is available to any GHS senior pursuing a junior college, four-year college and those in a non-degree program. Criteria include upper 50% of graduating class and reside within District #205. **Deadline: April 15, 2011.**
3. The Ann Asplund Scholarship will be awarded to a worthy GHS senior who has a GPA 2.5+, an attendance rate of 90%+, attended GHS for four consecutive years, and plans to continue their education. This is a \$500 scholarship! **Deadline: April 15, 2011.**
4. Seniors who are members of the tennis team may apply to the Art Fish Tennis Scholarship. The applicants should demonstrate scholarship, attitude, work ethic, sportsmanship, and proper demeanor. **Deadline: April 15, 2011.**
5. GHS seniors who attended Costa Catholic School are encouraged to apply for the Bernice Henry Howard Scholarship. **Deadline: April 1, 2011.**
6. Carl Sandburg College Annual and Endowment Scholarships are available to seniors who are attending CSC. The CSC Scholarship Directory is available for checkout in the Guidance Center or online at [www.sandburg.edu](http://www.sandburg.edu). **Deadline: March 1, 2011.**
7. Carl Sandburg College Talent Grants are available for the following areas: Art (due April 8), Creative Writing (due April 8), Theatre (due April 18), Music (due April 15), and Journalism (due April 8). Applications are available in the Guidance Center.
8. The Charles F. West Memorial Scholarship is available to students pursuing a major in education. Also, a GPA of 2.0+ and letter of recommendation from a District #205 teacher is required. Applications are available in the GHS Guidance Center. **Deadline: April 1, 2011.**
9. The Dave's Auto Body Scholarship is available to any GHS senior with a 2.5 GPA+, 90% or better attendance during high school, and plans to continue their education in a technical field. **Deadline: March 11, 2011.**
10. David E. & Alice D. Harris Scholarship is for seniors with a GPA 2.5+, ethnic minority, good reputation and good attendance. Seniors must submit proof of acceptance from post-secondary institute. **Deadline: April 20, 2011.**
11. Seniors who are planning to pursue a degree in business or business education as a full-time student is encouraged to apply for the Dolores M. Ryner Business Scholarship. Requirements include a GPA 3.0+ and completed at least one business class at GHS. **Deadline: March 11, 2011.**
12. The Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Scholarship is available to seniors who demonstrate financial need and have a GPA 2.0+. **Deadline: April 15, 2011.**
13. Any GHS senior displaying (French, German, Latin, or Spanish) language ability, good character, and academic standing that are planning to use foreign language in their career are encouraged to apply for the Foreign Language Club Scholarship. Applications are available in the foreign language department. **Deadline: April 1, 2011.**
14. The Francis E. "Buck" and Dianne Bailey Memorial Scholarship is now available. The only essential criteria for this scholarship are that the applicant show evidence of a Christian commitment and live in Knox County. Applications are available in the Guidance Center. **Deadline: June 30, 2011.**
15. Galesburg Community Foundation sponsors a scholarship grant for students who have been accepted in a health care professional sequence. Applications are available in the Guidance Center or at [www.endowgburg.org](http://www.endowgburg.org). **Deadline: April 15, 2011.**
16. For any senior planning to major in education, the Galesburg Education Association Scholarship is for you. Check to see if funding is available each year. **Deadline: April 7, 2011.**

17. The Galesburg High School Class of 1959 has established this \$500 scholarship in remembrance of their class and the opportunities afforded it by both faculty and staff. The recipient must have attended GHS for four consecutive years and be on track to graduate, GPA 2.5+, been accepted to an institution of higher learning, be of good character, dependable, and shown loyalty to GHS. **Deadline: April 1, 2011.**
18. The George W. and Janet M. Lundeen Memorial Scholarship is open to seniors with a GPA of 3.0+ who participated in a sport at GHS. Other criteria include plans to major in education or physical education with a career goal of school administration, teaching, coaching, or a related field. **Deadline: April 30, 2011.**
19. The Harris Trucking Scholarship is available to a GHS senior with a GPA of 2.5+, ethnic minority, good reputation, and documentation of 20 hours of volunteer work. **Deadline: April 20, 2011.**
20. If you have been accepted into a school of nursing, the Helen H. Wetherbee Nursing Scholarship is for you! This \$1,250 award is to be applied to tuition, fees, room and board, or books. Applications are available in the Guidance Center or at [www.endowgburg.org](http://www.endowgburg.org). **Deadline: April 15, 2011.**
21. The Helen Scharenberg Peters Scholarship is offered to a graduating female senior who will be attending Knox College. This female must have a 2.0+ GPA and been accepted to Knox College. **Deadline: April 1, 2011.**
22. The Hispanic Latino Resource Group, Inc. will once again award scholarships to two (2) graduating seniors of Hispanic descent. Seniors who are planning to continue their education need to fill out an application, submit teacher recommendation, write an essay, and submit a copy of the college acceptance letter. These memorial scholarships are given in honor and memory of Erica Hunter and Adam Perez. Applications and information are available in the Guidance Center or at [www.knoxcountypareaproject.org](http://www.knoxcountypareaproject.org). **Deadline: May 1, 2011.**
23. Irma Gale Service League Scholarship is open to all GHS senior girls who plan to further their education. **Deadline: April 1, 2011.**
24. The Jason Gray Memorial College Scholarship will be awarded to a senior from GHS and Knoxville High School. This \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a student who has lettered in a varsity sport, GPA 2.5+, planning to pursue their education with preference given to students interested in coaching athletic teams at the elementary, middle, or secondary level. Applications are available in the Guidance Center. **Deadline: April 15, 2011.**
25. A GHS senior with three years of lab science, preferably one in physics and has expressed an intent to pursue a career involving science may be chosen for the John Aitchison Scholarship. The GHS Science Department chooses the recipient. **Deadline: mid May.**
26. The John Thiel Memorial Scholarship is given to a GHS senior boy basketball player with the highest GPA. No application necessary.
27. The Karyn Brodine Memorial Art Teacher Scholarship is available to one high school student in Knox County who plans to become an art teacher or major in some facet of art. Criteria include: GPA 3.0+, upper 50% of graduating class, continues education. **Deadline: April 15, 2011.**
28. The Knox County Extension Education Foundation currently offers two \$500 scholarships for seniors who have been a member of a Knox County 4-H club and are enrolling full-time at a university, college, junior college, or technical school. Applications are available in the Guidance Center or at <http://webextension.illinois.edu/knox.youthdev1196.html>. **Deadline: May 14, 2011.**
29. The Louis A. Lakis Memorial Scholarship is available to all GHS seniors with a 3.0+ GPA and in the upper 50% of the graduating class. Recommendation, personal statement, and copy of acceptance letter from institution you plan to attend are required. **Deadline: April 15, 2011.**
30. The Marcus L. Daniel Memorial Scholarship will be awarded to GHS senior who has a GPA of 2.5+ and plans to major in Special Education at an accredited institution of higher learning (2- or 4-year college). Also, the applicant must have a minimum one-year membership in either Rotary Interact Club or Tomorrow's Teachers. Applications are available in the Guidance Center. **Deadline: April 15, 2011.**

31. Marjorie Preston Sargeant Scholarship is open to seniors with a 3.0+ GPA, planning to major in any facet of education and has been accepted into any university or college in the state of Illinois. **Deadline: April 1, 2011.**
32. The Mary Davis McKnight Scholarship is available to students who have lost one or both parents, lives in Knox or Warren County, and will attend Knox or Monmouth College, or Carl Sandburg College. **Deadline: April 1, 2011.**
33. A senior with 2.0+ GPA and majoring in speech/language, health care, health or social services, medicine is eligible to apply on the Mary F. Egan Scholarship KCCDD. Priority is given to a family member of KCCDD employee. **Deadline: June 1, 2011.**
34. A senior from GHS who intends to major in the communications field and in the upper 40% of their graduating class should apply for the Mauzy Beck Scholarship. **Deadline: April 1, 2011.**
35. The Max Wine Memorial Scholarship will be awarded to a worthy GHS senior with plans to continue their education, has a cumulative GPA of 2.5+, and attendance of 90%+. Two letters of recommendation, official letter of acceptance and a brief statement are required. This \$200 scholarship can be renewed for three additional years. **Deadline: April 15, 2011.**
36. McDonald's—Ray Kroc Scholarship is for any GHS senior or senior employed by McDonalds. This scholarship is for those "unsung heroes" who possess characteristics of good citizenship, leadership, scholarship, and sportsmanship. **Deadline: April 1, 2011.**
37. The Mellinger Foundation awards scholarships to local students. This is a lengthy application. Transcripts, parents' financial statements, and your SAR (Student Aid Report) are required. There are several criteria for this award; however, the two most important are academic achievement and financial need. **Deadline: May 1, 2011.**
38. The Mike Tadie Scholarship will be selected by the GHS Cross Country and/or Track coach to aid a worthy GHS student who is a participant on the cross country/track team with running shoes.
39. The Morgan Family Scholarship is now available to students who attended Churchill Jr. High School and is a senior letter winner in either Varsity Boys or Girls basketball. Also, the recipient must have demonstrated strong effort toward academic achievement and will be continuing their education. This is a \$1,000 scholarship! **Deadline: April 1, 2011.**
40. The Patti Jeanne Higgins 4-H Scholarship is available for seniors or first year college students who are residents of Mercer or Warren Counties and involved in 4-H for a minimum of three years. Applications are available in the Guidance Center. **Deadline: March 31, 2011.**
41. P.E.O. Scholarship: MG Chapter sponsors a scholarship for a GHS senior girl with financial need, good character, and academics. Selected by MG Chapter. **Deadline: April 1, 2011.**
42. A GHS senior, majoring in special education or health care, may apply for the Pilot Club of Galesburg Scholarship. Two letters of recommendation, written essay, interview, and transcript are required for this scholarship. **Deadline: June 1, 2011.**
43. For a GHS senior who participated in wrestling during all four years at GHS and has the highest accumulative GPA, the Reginald and Dorothy Mustain Memorial Scholarship is available. No application necessary.
44. The Rose Skaloud Memorial Scholarship is awarded annually in memory of Rose Skaloud. A \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to both a male and female student who best fulfills the criteria: pursuing a four-year degree in the mathematics or science field, attend an four-year college or university, and has demonstrated involvement in a IHSA competitive activity (athletics, music, speech, etc.). **Deadline: April 15, 2011.**
45. The Rotary Club (Sunrise) of Galesburg is offering a scholarship for seniors with a GPA of 2.5+, financial need, 90% attendance rate during their tenure at GHS. Immediate family members of Rotary are not eligible. **Deadline: April 1, 2011.**
46. A senior with 2.0+ GPA, graduating in the upper 50% of the graduating class, having good character, is dependable, and pursuing an education in vocational education, communication, or graphics should apply for the Roy Damberg Memorial Scholarship. **Deadline: March 11, 2011.**

47. The Russ Benjamin Award is granted to a graduating senior art student who will continue studying art in college and show creative talent in drawing, painting, or graphics. Information is available from any GHS art teacher.
48. Scholastic Bowl Scholarship is awarded to a college bound senior who participates in scholastic bowl activities with a large contribution to success of the activity. **Deadline: April 1, 2011.**
49. The Spark & Dick Burgland Athletic Achievement Scholarship is awarded to a GHS senior, top 25% of graduating class, 3-year sport participant and planning to continue education. No application necessary.
50. The Spark Burgland Memorial Basketball Scholarship is awarded to a GHS senior girl or boy on the varsity basketball team. Other criteria included GPA of 2.5+, displays exemplary conduct both on and off the court, strong moral character, good sportsmanship, leadership, teamwork, and exceptional determination and effort, good work habits, good attendance and punctuality. **Deadline: April 1, 2011.**
51. A GHS senior who has chosen to pursue a career in education should apply for the Student Action for Education Scholarship. **Deadline: April 1, 2011.**
52. Support Group for African American Affairs Scholarship is open to African American seniors planning to continue their education. Criteria include GPA of 2.5+ and letter of recommendation. **Deadline: February 4, 2011.**
53. The Verna May Sargent Vocal Music Scholarship will be awarded to a GHS senior who is planning to major in music or a music-related field. Students with an emphasis in voice have priority. This \$1,200 scholarship! **Deadline: April 15, 2011.**
54. Walt Younker Agriculture Scholarship is available to any GHS senior who is planning on attending college and majoring in an agriculture-related field. Applicants must also be in the top half of their graduating class. This is a \$500 award. **Deadline: April 1, 2011.**
55. The Wanda B. Sargent Memorial Art Scholarship will be awarded annually to a GHS senior with plans to continue their education in the art field. Other requirements include: GPA 2.5+ and 90%+ attendance rate. This is a \$500 scholarship award. **Deadline: April 15, 2011.**
56. The Wes Corzette Memorial Baseball Award is awarded to a GHS senior boy on the varsity baseball team with outstanding athletic ability, exceptional courage, and leadership, scholastic achievement, and strong moral character. **Deadline: May 2011.**
